2. Must reside in Sampson and/or Harnett County.
3. Must be actively involved with the Coharie Tribe.
4. Must be knowledgeable of Federal, State, and Local Tribal Programs.
5. Be knowledgeable of the Federal Acknowledgement Process.
6. Have the time, finances, and willingness to serve and represent across the Nation.
7. Educational level must be at least a High School Graduate.
8. Have a criminal check done.
9. Length of term 4 years and can be re-elected.
10. Good community standing.
